The Yard Sale is being combined with our Dog Walk this year, to bring traffic into the event and also help raise funds from the sale of many items ranging from household items to pet items to clothing. All have been donated to Wishbone through our Wishbone House Thrift Store.

The Annual Dog Walk is a great outdoor event for the entire family. You will meet lots of fellow dog lovers, there is an adoption tent with animals from the Allegan Shelter, and a demonstration from our Professional Shelter Dog Behaviorist. Come be a part of the party and help Wishbone raise money to care for needy animals.
